Concept Note:

Marginalization is being defined as a very complex process of relegating specific communities to the margins, the process which effectively pushes various social groups on the edge and cuts it from the 'mainstream'. Socially, economically, politically and educationally deprived communities are at the extremes of insecurity and discrimination. Realization of human potential and consequences of deprivation led to the larger Santal communities and tribals in general to assume much significant role for the social development.

The hierarchies of caste, economic status and gender have increasingly been used as a tool to perpetuate various forms of inequalities among Santal community. Lately Santals have recognized educational attainment as the major critical component for development, dignity, and socio-economic mobility. For them access to education has been a focal point in the struggle of equality and social justice. Although the Santals settled in the West Midnapore district of West Bengal got immensely benefited by the several policies, programs and schemes implemented by the state government of west Bengal under the direct leadership of the Chief Minister, yet there might be glitches at times due to lack of lower level bureaucratic set up which this seminar would like to explore.

Similarly different evil practices and traditions like manual scavenging, bonded labor and child labor take a heavy toll on Santal children forcing them to drop out of schools at an early age. The key components in ensuring inclusion of Santals are management and planning of cutting edge. In the present day Santals have got special focus especially in West Bengal but the empowerment in real sense of the term is yet to be looked at. Special emphasis with respect to the multidimensional focus needs to be understood. Tribal's in India far excluded socially and representation in the institutions is abysmally low. Santals being one of the largest community has had been victims of dangerous forms of oppression.

The proposed seminar would like to discuss, debate and conceptualize the marginalization and provide trends of the institutional attitudes and policy segments towards the improvement and strengthening of human and social capital of Santal community.
